










When you beat a drum or pluck a banjo string, it causes a **vibration**. When vibrations happen, sound is made.

Vibrations can spread from one object to another, like with the drum and the rice.

Vibrations can also spread to the air and to another object, like with the banjo and gelatin.

When vibrating air reaches the inside of our ear, that begins to vibrate too – and that's how we hear sounds!





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
