




Weather is a description of what it is like outside right now.

Precipitation





























Precipitation is water that falls from the sky. How many different kinds of precipitation can you name?








Wind direction can be found using a **wind vane**. The arrow turns to point into the wind.

This wind vane is pointing South, so the wind is blowing from the South.

Temperature is a measure of how warm or cold it is.

Temperature is measured using a thermometer.

The units of temperature are **degrees Fahrenheit** (°F) or **degrees Celsius** (°C).

Temperatures are measured in the shade, so the Sun's rays do not heat up the instrument.
