# What are articles?



**Articles** are words that are used with nouns to form **noun phrases**. The article is a special form of **adjective** that comes before the noun and helps to define it.

‘A’, ‘an’ and ‘the’ are all articles. See how they can be used to form noun phrases.



Article	Noun
a	dog
an	apple
the	reason

**Quantifiers** are also a type of **adjective**. They express the quantity of something, for example, how many or how much of something there is.



Common examples of quantifiers include:

Some   many   all   every  
most   every   a lot  
none   few
