**Imagery** refers to any literary technique that an author uses to create an image for the reader. These images usually serve to produce a certain **mood** or **tone**.

Mood and tone are different, but equally important, elements of literature.

**Mood** describes the emotions that an author creates in the reader.

**Tone** is the author's attitude toward his or her subject.

An author's word choice has enormous impact on both mood and tone.
